Beginner's LUCKraft Written Pattern

My knitting and Pattern is

- Complete Seamless or tiny bit of seamed.
- Size Adjustable, I always talk how to adjust the number to your size!
- You must watch my YouTube tutorial video with this written pattern for better understanding.
- You can use any needle and any yarn you want, which means you MUST knit your swatch and take a gauge.

YARN: YARNSPIRATIONS CARON SIMPLY SOFT WHITE: LESS THAN 1 BALL

NEEDLE: 3.75 MM

GAUGE: 4" X 4" = 21 STS X 28 ROWS

HEAD MEASUREMENT: 22"

4" VS 22" = 21 STS VS [X STS]

$X = 22 \times 21 / 4$

X = 115

CAST ON: MULTIPLE OF 11

I PICKED 110, IF THIS # IS NOT MULTIPLE OF 2, ADD 1 ST, BECAUSE ONLY RIB SHOULD BE MULTIPLE OF 2

CAST ON: 110 OR YOUR CHOICE

RIB: (K1, P1) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

Beginner's LUCKraft Written Pattern

I KNITTED ABOUT 4" BECAUSE I WAS GOING TO MAKE DOUBLE RIB

DOUBLE RIB: FOLD IN HALF, PICK UP THE BOTTOM ST, AND (K2TOG, P2TOG) UNTIL ALL STS ARE ATTACHED

HEAD CABLED PART

R1: ALL KNIT – IF YOU INCREASED ST FOR RIB, NOW YOU MUST DECREASE 1 ST

R2: (P4, K2, [HALF K1, YO, K1], SL1P, [HALF K1, YO, K1], K2)

R3: (K6, SL3P, K1, SL3P, K2)

R4: (P4, C2/3B, SL1P, C3/2F)

REP R1 ~ R4 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH / AT LEAST COVER YOUR HEAD

AFTER THIS ONLY 13 ROWS TO FINISH

I REPEATED 14 TIMES / 9" FROM THE BOTTOM

DECREASING

DR1: (K2TOG, K9) = 10

DR2: (P3, K2, [HALF K1, YO, K1], SL1P, [HALF K1, YO, K1], K2) = 10

DR3: (K2TOG, K3, SL3P, K1, SL3P, K2) = 9

DR4: (P2, C2/3B, SL1P, C3/2F) = 9

DR5: (K2TOG, K7) = 8

DR6: (P1, K2, [HALF K1, YO, K1], SL1P, [HALF K1, YO, K1], K2) = 8

DR7: (K2TOG, K1, SL3P, K1, SL3P, K2) = 7

DR8: (C2/3B, SL1P, C3/2F) = 7

DR9: (K2TOG, K3, K2TOG) = 5

DR10: (K1, [HALF K1, YO, K1], SL1P, [HALF K1, YO, K1], K1)

DR11: (K1, SL3P, K1, SL3P, K1) = 5

DR12: (C1/3B, SL1P, C3/1F) = 5

DR13: (K2TOG, K1, K2TOG) = 3

Beginner's LUCKraft Written Pattern

DR14: (K2TOG)

IF YOU STILL HAVE TOO MANY STS TO CLOSE THE TOP OF YOUR HAT, YOU CAN REPEAT DR13 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE STS COUNT

WEAVE THE ENDS OFF

BO=BIND OFF

DR=DECREASING ROW

K=KNIT

K2TOG=KNIT 2 TOGETHER

M=MARKER

P=PURL

P2TOG=PURL 2 TOGETHER

R=ROW

SSK=SLIP SLIP KNIT

ST=STITCH

STS=STITCHES

YO=YARN OVER

YF=YARN FRONT

YB=YARN BACK

C2/3B=CABLE 2/3 BACK

C3/2F=CABLE 3/2 FRONT
