My concept of knitting & pattern is all about knitting the size you want.

We all have a different shape, body trait, preference, and so on, then why do you have to knit the same as everybody?!

My knitting and Pattern is

- Complete Seamless or tiny bit of seamed.
- Size Adjustable, I always talk how to adjust the number to your size!
- You may watch my YouTube tutorial video with this written pattern for better understanding.
- You can use any needle and any yarn you want, which means you MUST knit your swatch and take a gauge.

YARN: LOOPS & THREADS LITTLE TREASURES #3, 557 YRDS / 7 OZ, 510 M / 200 G – LESS THAN 1 BALLS

SIZE: SMALL (I'M 5'2" & 100 LB)

NEEDLE: 4 MM

SWATCH & GAUGE: 4" X 4" = 22 STS X 28 ROWS

NECK ROUND OPENING: 17"

4": 17" = 22 STS: [X STS]

[X STS] = 17 X 22 / 4

[X STS] = 93.5

PICK THE NUMBER WITH MULTIPLE OF 12 = 96

BASE # IS 96 / 6 = 16

BACK = BASE X 2 → 16 X 2 = 32

BOTH SLEEVE = (BASE X 1) X 2 → 16 X 2 = 32

BOTH FRONT = 2 X 2 → 4

ALL ADD IT UP = 32 + 32 + 4 = 68 → This is the CAST ON #

[V neck]

BACK / 2 - 2

32 / 2 - 2 = 14

INCREASE 1 ST EVERY 4<sup>TH</sup> ROW

14 X 4 = 56 ROWS = 8"

[CAST ON] 68 or your # based on your gauge

[INCREASING] ADD Ms: 2 / BASE # X1 / BASE # X2 / BASE # X1 / 2

FOR ME, 2 / 16 / 32 / 16 / 2

IR1(WS): ALL PURL

IR2(RS): K UNTIL LAST 1 ST BEFORE THE RAGLAN M, M1R, (SM), M1L

YOU DO SAME THING AT EVERY SINGLE RAGLAN Ms = 8 STS INCREASE IN THIS ROW

IR3(WS): ALL PURL

IR4(RS): K1, M1R, K UNTIL LAST 1 ST BEFORE THE RAGLAN M, M1R, (SM), M1L,

YOU DO SAME THING AT EVERY SINGLE RAGLAN Ms, THEN K UNTIL LAST 2 STS, M1L, K1

REPEAT IR1 ~ IR4 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

[FOR V NECK INCREASE]

(BACK STS - 4 STS) / 2 = 14 STS

14 STS X 4 ROWS = 56 ROWS

[RAGLAN INCREASE]

INCREASE UNTIL SLEEVES MEET UNDER YOUR ARMPIT

\*\* RAGLAN INCREASING IS THE REPEAT OF IR1 & IR2 \*\*

[SEPARATE SLEEVES] NO MORE INCREASING

- ON RS, K UNTIL FIRST RAGLAN M, TRANSFER ALL THE SLEEVE STS
- ADD FEW NEW CASTS (1" ~ 3" WORTH OR MORE LESS) I ADDED 8 STS (ABOUT 1.5")
- START KNITTING BACK PS UNTIL THE OTHER SIDE OF SLEEVE
- DO THE SAME THING

[CONNECTION FOR FRONT]

ON RS, ADD 2 STS, THEN CONNECT RIGHT & LEFT FRONT

[FINISH THE BODY] KNIT IN ROUND UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

[BODY RIB] MULTIPLE OF 4 / WITH 3.5 MM NEEDLE

(K2, P2) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

[BIND OFF] USE 4 MM NEEDLE

[SLEEVE CONNECTION]

TRANSFER ALL SLEEVE STS ONTO THE NEEDLE

ADD MARKER AS FOLLOWINGS

1. BEFORE LAST ORIGINAL
2. IN THE CENTER OF NEW CASTS (BEG M)
3. BEFORE LAST NEW CASTS

KNIT UP

2 EXTRA, ABOVE NEW CASTS (8 STS FOR ME), 2 EXTRA, ALL KNIT UNTIL 1ST MARKER, SSK, K2TOG, K UNTIL 2ND MARKER, SSK, K2TOG, ALL KNIT UNTIL BEG M

[SLEEVE]

KNIT IN ROUND UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

[SLEEVE RIB] MULTIPLE OF 4 / WITH 3.5 MM NEEDLE

(K2, P2) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

[BIND OFF] USE 4 MM NEEDLE

[2 X 2 RIBBING V NECK]

KNIT UP AROUND THE NECK

RULE

1. TOTAL STS COUNT SHOULD BE MULTIPLE OF 4
2. AT THE BOTTOM OF V NECK, THESE HAVE TO BE KNIT STITCHES

VR1 & 2(RS): (K2, P2) IN ROUND – ADD M IN THE CENTER OF 2 BOTTOM STITCHES

VR3(RS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS, UNTIL 2 STS BEFORE THE M, K2TOG, (SM), SSK, K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS UNTIL THE END

REPEAT VR3 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

[BIND OFF]

BO=BIND OFF

DEC=DECREASE

IR=INCREASING ROW

KFB=KNIT FRONT & BACK

K=KNIT

K2TOG=KNIT 2 TOGETHER

M=MARKER

M1R=MAKE 1 RIGHT

M1L=MAKE 1 LEFT

P=PURL

PSSO=PASS SLIP STITCH OVER

P2TOG=PURL 2 TOGETHER

RS=RIGHT SIDE

R=ROW

SSK=SLIP SLIP KNIT

ST=STITCH

STS=STITCHES

WS=WRONG SIDE

YO=YARN OVER

YF=YARN FRONT

YB=YARN BACK

C4B=CABLE 4 BACK

C4F=CABLE 4 FRONT

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
