# Agasalhos e Bugalhos yarn creations and designs

#### Boreal Baby Hat



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You can sell items made from this pattern, provided that they are handmade by yourself and you give credit to the designer.

Expert Level: Advanced Beginner Approx. Finished measurements:

Size	To fit approx· Baby Head Circumference	Hat Height (with the bottom edge rolled up)
0-1m	±34-36cm	±13cm
	±13,5"-14,25"	±5"
1-3m	±36-38cm	±14cm
	±14,25"-15"	±5,5"
3-6m	±38-40cm	±15cm
	±15"-15,75"	±6"
6-9m	±40-42cm	±16cm
	±15,75"-16,5"	±6,25"
9-12m	±42-44cm	±17cm
	±16,5-17,5"	±6,75"

Tension: 25 stitches x 34 rows = 10cm / 4" in stockinette stitch with 3,5mm (US 4) needles.

Please complete a tension square.

#### Materials:

- Yarn: DK weight 100% Merino Wool Merino 4 Us Rosários 4, approx· 50g/125m

You can also use Katia 100% Merino Wool 50g/102m

Size	Yarn	
0-1m	±30g / ±65m / 1 balls	
1-3m	±40g / ±85m / 1 ball	
3-6m	±50g / ±105m / 1-2 ball(s)	
6-9m	±60g / ±125m / 2 balls	
9-12m	±70g / ±145m / 2 balls	

- 3,5mm (US 4) straight or circular needles
- tapestry needle
- scissors, measuring tape

#### Abbreviations:

cm - centimeters

**K** - knit

**K2tog** - knit 2 stitches together

Kfb1 - knit in the front and back of stitch

P - purl

PM - place marker

RS - right side

SL1 - slip a stitch

SM - slip marker

**SSK** - slip slip knit (decrease)

st(s) - stitch(es)

WS - wrong side

**YO** - yarn over (makes a new stitch)

Note: All the sizes of this pattern were tested and I did my best to ensure that these instructions are accurate and complete. However I cannot be responsible for variations in individual work, typographical errors, or if the specified yarn weight recommended for this pattern has not been used. It is very important that you complete a tension square with the yarn and needles of your preference.

SIZES: 0-1 (1-3, 3-6, 6-9, 9-12) months The hat is Knitted from the bottom up

#### **BODY**

elasticity to the bottom of the hat, but you can use the method you prefer.

□Row 1 (RS): Knit all sts.

 $\square$ Row 2 (W5): K1, Purl until 1 st remains, K1.

Repeat these two last rows until the work measures approx  $\cdot$  10 (11, 12, 13, 14) cm / 4"(4,25", 4,75", 5", 5,5") from the beginning, ending on a wrong side row



TOP OF THE HEAD DECREASES

□Row 1 (RS): K1, [SSK, K15 (16, 17, 18, 19)]

sts, K2tog] x 4 times, K1.

You have 70 (74, 78, 82, 86) sts.

□Row 2 (WS): K1, Purl until 1 st remains, K1.

 $\square$ Row 3 (R5): K1, [55K, K13 (14, 15, 16, 17) sts, K2tog] x 4 times, K1.

You have 62 (66, 70, 74, 78) sts.

□Row 4 (WS): K1, Purl until 1 st remains, K1.

 $\square$ Row 5 (RS): K1, [SSK, K11 (12, 13, 14, 15) sts, K2tog] x 4 times, K1.

You have 54 (58, 62, 66, 70) sts.

□Row 6 (WS): K1, Purl until 1 st remains, K1.

 $\square$ Row 7 (RS): K1, [SSK, K9 (10, 11, 12, 13) sts, K2tog] x 4 times, K1.

You have 46 (50, 54, 58, 62) sts.

□Row 8 (W5): K1, Purl until 1 st remains, K1.

 $\square$ Row 9 (R5): K1, [S5K, K7 (8, 9, 10, 11) sts, K2tog] x 4 times, K1.

You have 38 (42, 46, 50, 54) sts.

□Row 10 (WS): K1, Purl until 1 st remains, K1.

 $\square$ Row 11 (R5): K1, [SSK, K5 (6, 7, 8, 9) sts, K2tog] x 4 times, K1.

You have 30 (34, 38, 42, 46) sts.

□Row 12 (WS): K1, Purl until 1 st remains, K1.

 $\square$ Row 13 (R5): K1, [SSK, K3 (4, 5, 6, 7) sts, K2tog] x 4 times, K1.

You have 22 (26, 30, 34, 38) sts.

□Row 14 (WS): K1, Purl until 1 st remains, K1.

 $\square$ Row 15 (R5): K1, [S5K, K1 (2, 3, 4, 5) sts, K2tog] x 4 times, K1.

You have 14 (18, 22, 26, 30) sts.

□Row 16 (WS): K1, Purl until 1 st remains, K1.

Only on the sizes O-1 (1-3) months:

 $\square$ Row 17 (R5): [K2tog] repeat until the end·

You have 7(9) sts.

Only on the sizes 3-6 (6-9, 9-12) months:

 $\square$ Row 17 (RS): K1, [SSK, K1 (2, 3) sts, K2tog] x 4 times, K1.

You have 14 (18, 22) sts.

□Row 18 (W5): K1, Purl until 1 st remains, K1...

 $\square$ Row 19 (R5): [K2tog] repeat until the end· You have 7 (9, 11) sts·



#### MAKE UP

□Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the back seam.

□ Pass the thread through the remaining sts, with the help of a tapestry needle·



# □ Sew the back seam together.

I advise you to use an invisible seam but you can use the method you prefer.

### □Weave in the yarn ends.

I advise you to weave the yarn on bottom of the right side of work because, as the bottom of the hat is rolled up, it will stay hidden.



# □Block the piece.

 $\square$  Suggestion: Add a cute pompom to the top of the hat·
