*Fleur* is a cheerful confection of a shawl that combines simple garter stitch and whimsical bobbles in a sweet, easy to wear accessory. Meditative knit stitch is interrupted by just four rows of bobbly texture to achieve a shawl that delivers high impact flare with minimal effort.

In **VERSION 1** La Bien Aimee *Merino DK* creates lovely drape while Cosy Posy Yarn Co. *Fluff* adds light, fuzzy contrast. This version of *Fleur* brings to mind spring buds and summer blossoms but the colour and mood possibilities for this shawl are endless!

**VERSION 2** combines Espace Tricot *Grace* and *Halo* for a beautiful, sophisticated accessory. This low-contrast version also features smaller bobbles.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Wingspan:** 76<sup>"</sup> / 193 cm **Center Depth:** 25<sup>"</sup> / 63.5 cm

# YARN

**VERSION 1:** 

La Bien Aimee MERINO DK (100% Merino); 252 yds (230 m) / 115g MC: 3 skeins - shown in 'You had me at tricot' Or approximately 624 y (571 m) of a DK weight yarn.

Cosy Posy Yarn Co. FLUFF (74% Baby Suri Alpaca, 26% Silk); 328 yds (300 m) / 50g CC: 1 skein (held double throughout) - shown in 'Moonstone' Or approximately 302 y (276 m) of a similar laceweight yarn.

## **VERSION 2:**

Espace Tricot GRACE (75% Merino, 15% Cashmere, 10% Silk); 490 yds (448m) / 115g 2 skeins - shown in 'Glace' Or approximately 650 y (595 m) of a similar fingering weight yarn.

Espace Tricot HALO (72% Kid Mohair, 28% Silk); 459 yds (420m) / 50g 2 skeins - shown in 'Cathedral' Or approximately 730 y (668 m) of a similar laceweight yarn.

Please note that in Version 2, a strand of fingering weight and a strand of laceweight yarn are held together throughout.

## **NEEDLES & NOTIONS**

 $5~{\rm mm}$  (US 8) – 32" / 80 cm circular knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge 1 stitch marker Tapestry needle to weave in ends

# GAUGE

18 sts & 35 rows per 10 cm / 4" in garter stitch after blocking

## PATTERN

#### VERSION 1

Using circular needle and main colour (MC), CO 5 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Kfb, kfb, pm, kfb, kfb, k1. 9 sts.
Row 2 (WS): Kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1. 11 sts.
Row 3 (RS): Kfb, knit to 1 stitch before marker, kfb, sm, kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1. 4 sts increased.
Row 4 (WS): Kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1. 2 sts increased.

Repeat Rows 3 and 4 - 4 more times [41 sts].

#### Drop MC (without breaking) and attach CC to RS.

Remember, two strands of CC lace weight yarn are held together throughout. We wound our yarn into a cake and pulled a strand from the outside and center of the cake while knitting.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with CC **1 time** [47 sts]. Break CC.

#### Pick up MC.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with MC 7 times [89 sts].

#### Drop MC (without breaking) and attach CC to RS.

**Bobble Row (RS):** Kfb, k7, MB, (k6, MB) 4 times, k6, kfb, sm, MB (this is the center st), kfb, k6, (MB, k6) 4 times, MB, k6, kfb, k1 [93 sts]. **Next row (WS):** Kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 [95 sts]. Break CC.

#### Pick up MC

Work Rows 3 and 4 with MC 7 times [137 sts].

Drop MC (without breaking) and attach CC to RS.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with CC 1 time [143 sts]. Break CC.

#### Pick up MC.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with MC 7 times [185 sts].

Drop MC (without breaking) and attach CC to RS.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with CC 1 time [191 sts]. Break CC.

Pick up MC.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with MC 7 times [233 sts].

Drop MC (without breaking) and attach CC to RS.

Bobble Row (RS): Kfb, k2, MB, (k6, MB) 15 times, k6, kfb, sm, MB (this is the center st), kfb, k6, (MB, k6) 15 times, MB, k1, kfb, k1 [237 sts]. Next row (WS): Kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 [239 sts]. Break CC.

#### Pick up MC.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with MC 7 times [281 sts].





### Drop MC (without breaking) and attach CC to RS.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with CC 1 time [287 sts]. Break CC.

Pick up MC.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with MC 7 times [329 sts].

Drop MC (without breaking) and attach CC to RS.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with CC 1 time [335 sts]. Break CC.

Pick up MC.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with MC 7 times [377 sts].

Drop MC (without breaking) and attach CC to RS.

Bobble Row (RS): Kfb, k4, MB, (k6, MB) 25 times, k6, kfb, sm, MB (this is the center st), kfb, k6, (MB, k6) 25 times, MB, k3, kfb, k1. [381 sts] Next row (WS): Kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 [383 sts]. Break CC.

### Pick up MC.

Work Rows 3 and 4 with MC 7 times [425 sts]. Break MC.

### Attach CC to RS.

Bobble Row (RS): K1, MB, (k6, MB) 29 times, k6, kfb, sm, MB (this is the center st), kfb, (k6, MB) 30 times, k1. Next row (WS): Bind off loosely.

#### FINISHING

Lightly steam or wet-block to desired measurements. Enjoy!



# PATTERN

#### **VERSION 2**

Using circular needle and a strand each of fingering and laceweight yarn, CO 5 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Kfb, kfb, pm, kfb, kfb, k1. 9 sts.
Row 2 (WS): Kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1. 11 sts.
Row 3 (RS): Kfb, knit to 1 stitch before marker, kfb, sm, kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1. 4 sts increased.
Row 4 (WS): Kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1. 2 sts increased.

Repeat Rows 3 and 4 - 12 more times [89 sts].

**Bobble Row (RS):** Kfb, k7, MB, (k6, MB) 4 times, k6, kfb, sm, MB (this is the center st), kfb, k6, (MB, k6) 4 times, MB, k6, kfb, k1 [93 sts]. **Next row (WS):** Kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 [95 sts].

Work Rows 3 and 4 - 23 times [233 sts].

**Bobble Row (RS):** Kfb, k2, MB, (k6, MB) 15 times, k6, kfb, sm, MB (this is the center st), kfb, k6, (MB, k6) 15 times, MB, k1, kfb, k1 [237 sts]. Next row (WS): Kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 [239 sts].

Work Rows 3 and 4 - 23 times [377 sts].

**Bobble Row (RS):** Kfb, k4, MB, (k6, MB) 25 times, k6, kfb, sm, MB (this is the center st), kfb, k6, (MB, k6) 25 times, MB, k3, kfb, k1. [381 sts] **Next row (WS):** Kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 [383 sts].

Work Rows 3 and 4 - 7 times [425 sts].

Bobble Row (RS): K1, MB, (k6, MB) 29 times, k6, kfb, sm, MB (this is the center st), kfb, (k6, MB) 30 times, k1. Next row (WS): Bind off loosely.

#### FINISHING

Lightly steam or wet-block to desired measurements.

## ABBREVIATIONS

CC: contrast colour CO: cast on k: knit kfb: knit 1 leaving stitch on left needle, knit through back loop of the same stitch MC: main colour pm: place marker RS: right side sl: slip stitch sm: slip marker st(s): stitch(es) WS: wrong side yo: yarn over

MB (make bobble):

**VERSION 1** - K1, yo, k1, yo, k1 into the same st. Turn work, purl 5 sts. Turn work, knit 5 sts. Turn work, purl 5 sts. Turn work, sl1 knitwise 4 times, sl1 purlwise. Pass 4 sts over last st. With yarn in front, wrap yarn around the base of the bobble once (counter clockwise) and pull slightly.

**VERSION 2 -** K1, yo, k1 into the same st. Turn work, purl 3 sts. Turn work, knit 3 sts. Turn work, purl 3 sts. Turn work, sl1 knitwise 2 times, sl1 purlwise. Pass 2 sts over last st. With yarn in front, wrap yarn around the base of the bobble once (counter clockwise) and pull slightly.
