Heart to Heart Scarf



One heart into another; Easy, fun, and cute scarf; A perfect project for beginners.

Materials:

Finished Size: 29" (74 cm) X 7 1/2" (19 cm)

Yarn: Caron Simply Soft / Red / 6oz/170g; 315yds/288m; 70g/111oz; 130yds/118m

Gauge: 18 sts X 24 rows = 4" X 4" in St st

Needle: US 8 (5mm)

Skill: level:

BEGINNER

Abbreviations & Terms:

BO bind off make one / inc 1st m1begin purl Beg p CO cast on repeat rep right side k knit RS knit 2sts together as one st K2tog sl st slip stitch knit into the front and back kfb

St st stockinette stitch (k on RS, p on WS)

WS wrong side

Beg: CO 1 st **Row 1**: kfb --- 2sts

Row 2: kfb, k to end --- 3sts

Rep row 2, till 32 sts --- The first heart finished

Next row1 (WS): p

row2 (RS): k2tog to end ---16sts

row3: p **row4**: k

Rep next row 3 and row 4 till measured 7" from CO

Next row 1: (RS): kfb on every st. --- back on 32sts

row 2: (WS): k

Work on garter st (k on both side) about 13" --- Neck length finished (the length between two hearts)

Next row 1 (WS): p

row2 (**RS**): k2tog to end ---16sts

row3: p **row4**: k

Working on St st about 3".

Next row (RS)1: kfb on every sts. --- back on 32sts

row2: P

row 3: k to las 2 sts, k2tog

Rep Next row 3, till 1 st, then BO.

Heart to heart tube:

From WS of St st at either side of heart, pick and k16 sts. Work on St st 3" (same length as the other side of St st), BO then sew or sl st to the other side.
