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# INTRODUCTION

'Freddie' was born out of need to create something cute and cheerful to gift to my friends and family during these strange times. I wanted to make something that was both uplifting and easy to make.

The design is quite simple using a standard double crochet technique. There are two pieces to be made: body and hat. You will need fibrefill for this project. ## SIZE

Height (without hat) - 10cm/3.9 inches

## MATERIALS

**BLUE YARN** - Marriner Double Knit (Shade: Aqua) 100% Acrylic (1 ball = 100g) - we will need less than half of the ball)

**ORANGE YARN** - Marriner Double Knit (Shade: Jaffa) 100% Acrylic (1 ball = 100g) - we will only need a bit of this yarn for the hat; to be on the safe side I would suggest 1/3 of the ball

2mm/U.S. A-0 crochet hook

Black Safety Eyes size 6mm

Fibrefill

Stitch Marker

Tapestry Needle

Scissors

Tape Measure

## TECHNIQUES & GLOSSARY

The pattern consists of two parts: body and hat. Both are crocheted in a round. Below you can find links to my mini Youtube tutorials on the techniques used in this pattern (these are stand alone tutorials to save you some time if you don't want to go through the whole 'Freddie' tutorial linked above).

**Magic Ring (Amigurumi Ring)** - wrap yarn around your thumb and index finger into a circle, with a crochet hook grab the yarn end through the circle, yarn over and pull through the loop -

**Chains** - yarn over the crochet hook then pull through the loop -

**Double Crochet** - crochet hook into the stitch, yarn over & pull through, yarn over again and pull through 2 loops -

**Treble Crochet** - yarn over, crochet hook into the stitch, yarn over & pull through, yarn over and pull through 2 loops, yarn over again and pull through the last 2 loops -

**Double Treble** - yarn over twice, crochet hook into the stitch, yarn over & pull through = 4 loops, yarn over and pull through 2 loops 3 times -

**Double Crochet 2 Increase** - \*crochet hook into the stitch, yarn over and pull through = 2 loops, yarn over again, pull through two loops\* 2 times -

**Invisible Crochet Decrease** - crochet hook into the front loops of two stitches, yarn over and pull through 2 loops, yarn over again and pull through two remaining loops -

# ABBREVIATIONS

\*Note: This Pattern is written in British English

Rnd - Round

MR- magic ring

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

tr - triple crochet

dtr - double treble

inc - double crochet 2 increase

dec - invisible decrease

sts - stitches

(...) - work instructions following (...) as many times as indicated

# METHOD

## Part 1: BODY

6 dc into MR

Rnd 1 - 6 inc (12)

Rnd 2 - 12 dc

Rnd 3 - (1 dc, inc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4 - 18 dc

Rnd 5 - (2 dc, inc) x6 (24)

Rnd 6 - 24 dc

Rnd 7 - (3 dc, inc) x6 (30)

Rnd 8 - 30 dc

Rnd 9 - (4 dc, inc) x6 (36)

Rnd 10 - 36 dc

Rnd 11 - (5 dc, inc) x6 (42)

Rnd 12 - 42 dc

Rnd 13 - (6 dc, inc) x6 (48)

Rnd 14 - 48 dc

Rnd 15 - (7 dc, inc) x6 (54)

Rnd 16 - 54 dc

Rnd 17-22 (6 rounds) - 54 dc

Add eyes on row 6 from the top and stuff the toy with hollow fibre toy stuffing

Rnd 23 - (7 dc, dec) x6 (48)

Rnd 24 - (6 dc, dec) x6 (42)

Rnd 25 - (5 dc, dec) x6 (36)

Rnd 26 - (4 dc, dec) x6 (30)

Rnd 27 - (3 dc, dec) x6 (24)

Rnd 28 - (2 dc, dec) x6 (18)

Rnd 29 - (1 dc, dec) x6 (12)

Rnd 30 - 6 dec (6)

Fasten off and weave in the end

## Part 2: HAT

make 2 ch and 6 dc into the first chain (6)

Rnd 1 - 6 inc (12)

Rnd 2 - 1 dc, inc) x6 (18)

Rnd 3-6 (4 rounds) - 18 dc

Rnd 7 - (1 dc, dec) x6 (12)

Rnd 8 - (1 dc, 1 tr, 1 dtr - all into the first stitch; 1 dtr, 1 tr, 1dc - all into the next stitch) x6

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing

Sew the hat onto the toy's head
