YARN: CRAFT SMART VALUE NEON

NEEDE: 4MM, 5MM, 3MM

SWATCH: 4" X 4" = 25 STS X 30 ROWS WITH 4 MM

DOG NECK MEASUREMENT: 11"

4" VS 11" = 25 STS VS [X STS]

$4X = 11 \times 25$

$X = 11 \times 25 / 4$

$X = 68.75$

CAST ON MUST BE MULTIPLE OF 12: MY CHOICE IS 72

PATTERN BY BEGINNER'S LUCKRAFT

RIB: (K2, P2) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

IR2: ALL KNIT

IR3: (BEG), K1, M1L, K UNTIL 1 ST BEFORE (M1), M1R, K1, (M1) ALL KNIT

UNTIL (M2), K1, M1L, K UNTIL 1 ST

BEFORE (M3), M1R, K1, (M3) ALL KNIT UNTIL (BEG)

IR4: ALL KNIT

REP OF IR1 ~ IR4 UNTIL SLEEVES REACH UNDER ARMPIT

PATTERN BY BEGINNER'S LUCKRAFT

CABLE DESIGN IN ROUND (34 STS)

SET UP ROW (ONLY KNIT STS)

INC FOR C4F (LEFT TWIST) = K1, KFBF

INF FOR C4B (RIGHT TWIST) = KFBF, K1

C4F (CABLE 4 FRONT) = PICK UP 2 STS WITH CN & PUT IT OUT FRONT, K2 FROM LN, THEN K2 FROM CN

C4B (CABLE 2 BACK) = PICK UP 2 STS WITH CN & PUT IT OUT BACK, K2 FROM LN, THEN K2 FROM CN

CR1(RS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

CR2(WS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

CR3(RS): C4F OR C4B

CR4(WS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

LEASH OPENING

LR1: BIND OFF (10 STS BIND OFF)

LR2: ADD NEW CAST (SAME STS AS BIND OFF)

SEPARATE SLEEVES & BODY

TRANSFER SLEEVE STS ONTO SCRAP THREAD

ADD 4 CAST OR MORE OR LESS, AND THEN KNIT UNTIL THE OTHER SLEEVE

AFTER THIS KEEP KNITTING UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH FOR FRONT

(RS) KNIT UNTIL 2ND TUMMY M, THEN TRANSFER ALL THE TUMMY STS ONTO ST HOLDER

NOW YOU NEED TO KNIT ONLY BACK SIDE AND DECREASE SOME STITCH FOR BOTH SIDE

DECREASING BOTH SIDE OF BACK TO CREATE A LITTLE CURVE

PATTERN BY BEGINNER'S LUCKRAFT

DR1(RS): K1, SSK, K UNTIL LAST 3 STS, K2TOG, K1

DR2(WS): ALL PURL

REP OF DR1 & DR2 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

BEFORE YOU WANT TO STOP KNITTING FOR BACK PS, ON CR3, YOU WILL HAVE TO DECREASE STS

CR3:

FOR C4F, P/U 2 STS & PUT IT OUT FRONT, THEN K2TOG WITH CN & LN

FOR C4B, P/U 2 STS & PUT IT OUT BACK, THEN K2TOG WITH LN & CN

CR4: K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

\*\*RECONNECT EVERY PARTS BACK MUST BE ON RS

KNIT BACK PART ONE MORE TIME WITH DECREASE STS, AND KNIT UP ON THE SIDE (COUNT STS),

RIB: (K2, P2) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

BIND OFF WITH 1 SIZE BIGGER NEEDLES

[SLEEVES]

TRANSFER ALL THE STS ONTO NEEDLE

ADD NEW M: 1 ST BEFORE LAST ST

YOU WILL PICK UP 2 STS FOR BOTH SIDE, TOTAL OF 4 STS

WHERE?

FIRST 2 EXTRA STS: IN BETWEEN LAST ORIGINAL ST AND FIRST NEW CAST

LAST 2 EXTRA STS: IN BETWEEN LAST NEW CAST AND FIRST ORIGINAL ST

PATTERN BY BEGINNER'S LUCKRAFT

P/U 1ST EX ST WITH RN FROM BEHIND

P/U 2ND EX ST WITH RN FROM FRONT

KNIT UP NEW CASTS (4 STS FOR ME)

P/U 3RD EX ST WITH RN FROM BEHIND

P/U 4TH EX ST WITH RN FROM FRONT HOOK ONTO LN, THEN K2TOG WITH 1ST ORIGINAL ST

K UNTIL MARKER,

FLIP LAST ORIGINAL ST, THEN K2TOG WITH BACK LOOP (1ST EX ST)

K2TOG (2ND EX & 1ST NEW CAST)

K BEFORE LAST NEW CAST, K2TOG WITH BACK LOOP WITH 3RD EX

\*\*\* SLEEVE CONNECT HAS DONE \*\*\*

ALL KNIT UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

RIB: (K2, P2) WITH 1 SIZE SMALLER NEEDLE UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

BIND OFF WITH 1 SIZE BIGGER NEEDLE
