# **Materials & supplies**

- 1. Fine cotton yarn of white, brown, orange and light green colors (I used Egitto Titan Wool 120 m (≈131 yds)/50 g).
- 2. Hook size 2 mm (metal hook US 1/UK 1).
- **3.** Fiber filling.
- **4.** Safety eyes 7 mm.
- **5.** Black sewing thread.

## **Abbreviations**

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Hdc - half double crochet

Dc - double crochet

St - stitch

Inc - increase (2 sc or 2 dc in one stitch)

Dec - decrease (crochet next 2 st together)

BLO - back loops only

[n] Inc/Dec - increase/decrease [n] times in a

Sl st - slip stitch

() x... - repeat instructions in brackets ... times Number in () at the end of the Row indicates number of st in that Row

### **HEAD + BODY:**

Work with **White** yarn.

R1: 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

**R4:** (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

**R5:** (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

**R6:** (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

**R7:** (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

**R8:** (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)

**R9-16:** 48 sc (8 rounds)

**R17:** (6 sc, dec) x 6 (42)

**R18:** (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)

Stuff.

Stuff.

**R19:** BLO 36 sc

**R20-22:** 36 sc (3 rounds)

**R23:** (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

**R24-31:** 42 sc (8 rounds)

**R32:** (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)

**R33:** (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

**R34:** (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

Stuff.

**R35:** (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)

**R36:** (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)

Stuff to the top.

**R37:** 6 dec

Fasten off, close the hole.

The eyes were inserted while crocheting head. Approx. between R13-14. Distance between them is about 8 st.

In **R19**, crocheted on the BL, start to crochet dress around using remaining front loop:

**R1:** Ch 3, (1 dc, inc) x 18, sl st (54)

**R2:** Ch 3, 54 dc

**R3:** Ch 3, (8 dc, inc) x 6, sl st (60)

**R4:** Ch 3, 60 dc

**R5:** Ch 3, (9 dc, inc) x 6, sl st (66)

**R6:** Ch 3, 66 dc

**R7:** Ch 3, (10 dc, inc) x 6, sl st (72)

**R8:** Ch 3, 72 dc

**R9:** Ch 4, then crochet on that chain - sc into the 2nd chain from the hook, hdc, dc. Then skip 1 sc on the dress and sc next 2 stitches. Ch 4 and repeat first step again, then skip 1 sc, and sc next 2 st. Repeat this pattern to the end of the dress.



#### **LEGS:**

Make 2 details.

Start to crochet with **Brown** yarn.

R1: Make a chain of 7, 2 sc into the 2nd ch from the hook, sc next 4 ch, 4 sc in the last ch. Working on other side of beginning chain: sc in next 4 ch, Inc in the last chain (16).

**R2:** Inc, 1 sc, Inc, 2 sc, Inc, 1 sc, 2 Inc, 1 sc, Inc, 2 sc, Inc, 1 sc, Inc (24).

**R3:** 3 sc, Inc, 5 sc, Inc, 1 sc, 2 Inc, 1 sc, Inc, 5 sc, Inc, 3 sc (30)

**R4:** BLO 30 sc

Change yarn color to Light green.

**R5-7:** 30 sc (3 rounds)

**R8:** 6 sc, (1 sc, dec) x 6, 6 sc (24)

**R9:** 24 sc

**R10:** 6 sc, 6 dec, 6 sc (18)

**R11:** BLO 18 sc Stuff with fiber.

**R12:** (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)

Change yarn color to **Orange**.

**R13-15:** 12 sc (3 rounds)

Stuff. We won't stuff after that anymore.

Change yarn color to Brown.

**R16-18:** 12 sc (3 rounds)

Change yarn color to **Orange**.

**R19-21:** 12 sc (3 rounds)

Change yarn color to **Brown**.

**R22-24:** 12 sc (3 rounds)

Change yarn color to **Orange**.

**R25-27:** 12 sc (3 rounds)

Change yarn color to **Brown**.

**R28-30:** 12 sc (3 rounds)

Change yarn color to **Orange** 

**R31-33:** 12 sc (3 rounds)

In **R11** crocheted on the BLO, continue to crochet boot using remaining front loop.

**R1-5:** 18 sc.

Embroider shoe laces on the boots with brown yarn.

#### **ARMS:**

Make 2 details.

Start to crochet with **White** yarn.

R1: 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3-7:** 12 sc (5 rounds)

**R8:** (1 sc, dec) x 4 (8)

Change yarn color to **Brown**.

**R9-21:** 8 sc (13 rounds)

Stuff. Fold edges together and single crochet them. Leave long tail for assembly.



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### HAT:

Work with **Brown** yarn.

Stuff before sewing to the head.

R1: 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18) **R4:** (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

**R5:** BLO 24 sc

**R6-7:** 24 sc

**R8:** (6 sc, dec) x 3 (21)

**R9:** 21 sc

**R10:**  $(5 \text{ sc, dec}) \times 3 (18)$ 

**R11:** 18 sc

Finish round with sl st.

Make a chain of 3 and crochet 18 dc inc (2 dc in each st), sl st in the end.

#### **ASSEMBLY:**

Sew hat to the head previously securing it with pins.

Sew legs and arms.

Embroider mouth, nose and scar on the face with black sewing thread.

#### Bow-tie

In magic ring: ch 4, 5 tr, ch 4, sl st, ch 4, 5 tr, ch 4, sl st.

Pull the yarn and wrap it around in the middle of the bow couple times.

Embroider ribbon on the hat with Orange yarn.













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
