POUCHED DENIM SHIRT BABY BIB

Soft like a favorite chambray denim shirt, this baby bib features a decorative seed stitch pocket and a functional bottom catch-all pouch. Extra stitches on the side borders (short rows) ensure that the edge is neat and straight.

Materials & Supplies

1 ball Lily Sugar'n Cream Denim yarn (100% cotton 109m/120yds, 70.9g/2.5oz. or other worsted weight cotton yarn US size 7 (4.5mm) needles 2 Stitch Markers ½" button



7 1/2" width x 7" depth

Gauge

5 sts = 1"

Note

Short Rows are used on the Garter Stitch borders to keep blanket in a true square. If you are unfamiliar with this technique, please review a knitting reference.

Catch-all Pouch

CO 27 sts.

Knit 10 rows.

Bib Body

Row 1: CO 5 sts using either the knitted or cable cast-on method. Do not turn work. Knit across all 32 sts. Turn work.

Row 2: CO 5 sts. Do not turn work, k5, pm, purl to last 5 sts, pm, k5. You will now have 37 sts.

Rows 3, 5, 7, (RS): knit

Rows 4, 6, 8 (WS): k5, slip marker, purl to next marker, k5

Row 9: k5, sm, slip next st, wrap & turn, k5, turn, k5, sm, work wrap and next st together as k2tog, k to end.

Row 10: k5, sm, slip next st, wrap & turn, sm, k5, turn, k5, sm, work wrap and next st together as p2tog, p to marker, sm, k5

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Rows 11, 13, 15, 17, 19: knit

Rows 12, 14, 16, 18, 20: same as Row 4

Row 21: same as Row 9

Row 22: same as Row 10

Row 23: knit

Row 24: same as Row 4

Pocket Patterning Begins

Row 25: k23, p1, k to end

Row 26: k5, sm, p7, k1, p1, k1, p to marker, sm, k5

Row 27: k21, (p1, k1) twice, p1, knit to end

Row 28: k5, sm, p5 (k1, p1) 3 times, k1, p to marker, sm, k5

Row 29: k19, (p1, k1) 4 times, p1, knit to end

Row 30: k5, sm, p3, (k1, p1) 5 times, k1, p to marker, sm, k5

Row 31: same as Row 29

Row 32: same as Row 30

Row 33: k5, sm, slip next st, wrap & turn, k5, turn, k5, sm, work wrap and next st together as k2tog, k13, (p1, k1) 4 times, p1, k to end.

Row 34: k5, sm, slip next st, wrap & turn, sm, k5, turn, k5, sm, work wrap and next st together as p2tog, p2, (k1, p1) 5 times, k1, p to marker, sm, k5

Rows 35, 37, 39: same as Row 29

Rows 36, 38, 40: same as Row 30

End of Pocket Patterning

Rows 41 & 43: knit

Rows 42 & 44: same as Row 10

Upper Border

Knit 9 rows.

BO until 5 sts remain (including the 1 st on the right needle).

Neck Band

Knit every row over these 5 sts until neck band measures 6".

Buttonholes

Row 1: Knit 2, yo, k2tog, k1.

Rows 2 thru 10: knit

Repeat these 10 rows twice more.

Repeat Row 1 once more.

Knit 3 rows.

Last row: k2tog, BO 1 st, ssk, BO

Finishing

Fold up lower edge even with side borders to form drip pouch. With matching yarn, sew sides of pouch to borders. Securely sew button to left side of upper border. Weave in yarn tails. Block.
