YARN: LOOPS & THREADS JOY DK #3 TRICOT DOUBLE BONHEUR

NEEDLE: 2.75 mm

CROCHET HOOK: 3.25 mm

SWATCH & GAUGE: 4" X 4" = 25 STS X 32 ROWS

DESIRED NECK OPENING MEASUREMENT: 13

CAST ON: MULTIPLE OF 2 // I MADE 80

YOU NEED 42 STS FOR BACK DESIGN, SO YOU SHOULD START AT LEAST 70 STS.

I DID STREACHY CAST ON → WATCH MY VIDEO

RIB: (K1, P1) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH // I MADE 2"

ADD MARKERS FOR BACK DESIGN: 42 STS

ADD MARKERS FOR LEASH OPENING: UP TO YOU / 16 STS FOR MINE

AT THE SAME TIME, YOU MAKE A LEASH OPENING (OPTIONAL)

PATTERN BY BEGINNER'S LUCKRAFT

SET UP: ALL KNIT: K1, (PM), K1, (PM) M1L, ALL KNIT – ADD SIDE MARKERS

IR1: K until M, M1R, (SM), K1, (SM), M1L, K until BEG M

IR2: ALL KNIT

REP OF IR1 & IR2 UNTIL REACHES TOP OF FRONT LEGS, FINISH ON IR2

THEN LEG OPENING NEXT 2 ROWS

MY STS COUNT: BETWEEN BOTH LEGS: 11 STS

LEG OPENING ITSELF: 20 STS EACH

LR1: BIND OFF FOR LEG OPENINGS

LR2: ADD NEW CASTS JUST ABOVE THE STS YOU BIND OFF IN PREVIOUS ROW

BACK DESIGN (TOTAL OF 42 STS)

CABLE 4 DESIGN IN ROUND (BOTH SIDE 14 X 2 = 28 STS)

CR1: P1, KBL, P1, K8, P1, KBL, P1

CR2: P1, KBL, P1, C4F, C4B, P1, KBL, P1

TR6(RS): (A), P2, (D), (E), P2, (B)

TR7(WS): K2, PBL, K3, PBL X2, K3, PBL, K2

TR8(RS): P2, (A), P1, KBL X2, P1, (B), P2

(A) SL1 ON CN & HOLD IT FRONT, P2 FROM LN, KBL ON CN

(B) SL2 ON CN & HOLD IT BACK, KBL FROM LN, P2 ON CN

(D) SL1 ON CN & HOLD IT FRONT, KBL FROM LN WITHOUT DROPPING ST OFF FROM LN, KBL FROM CN, THEN DROP 2 STS OFF FROM LN TOGETHER

(E) SL1 ON CN & HOLD IT BACK, KBL FROM LN WITHOUT DROPPING ST OFF FROM LN, KBL FROM CN THEN DROP 2 STS OFF FROM LN TOGETHER

(F) SL1 ON CN & HOLD IT FRONT, (KBL, P1) FROM LN, KBL FROM CN

(G) SL2 ON CN & HOLD IT BACK, KBL FROM LN, (P1, KBL) FROM CN

(●) BY CROCHET, CH3, (HALFWAY OF HDC) X 2, PULL THROUGH 5 STS ON THE HOOK, SL ST WITH PREVIOUS ST: YOU MUST WATCH VIDEO

PATTERN BY BEGINNER'S LUCKRAFT

DECREASING ON RS

(RS) K1, SSK, (K & DESIGN) UNTIL LAST 3 STS, K2TOG, K1

(WS) ALL PURL

RECONNECT FRONT, BACK AND BOTH SIDES

THEN RIB (K1, P1) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

STRETCHY CAST OFF

ABBREVIATIONS

K=KNIT

P=PURL

R=ROW

IR=INCREASING ROW

CR=CABLE 4 ROW

TR=TREE DESIGN ROW

M=MARKERS

PM=PLACE THE MARKER

SM=SLIP MARKER

M1R=MAKE 1 RIGHT

M1L=MAKE 1 LEFT

SL=SLIP

KBL=KNIT BACK LOOP
