

Eric's Winter Scarf



This scarf was made for Angela's husband Eric. They live in Canada and both walk to work every day since they live in the center of their town. After I visited them in the summer, I thought I would make something for them.

I made a shawl for Angela and this merino scarf for Eric.

I love this yarn; it is very soft and warm. It will suit the weather in Canada.

Since I had 2 skeins of yarn, I used them all. You may repeat the pattern as long as you desire.



Yarn: 2 skeins Madelinetosh / Tosh Vintage 100% superwash merino wool / worsted weight / 200yds / 182m

Needle: US 8 (5mm) straight or 24" circular needle

Gauge: 19 sts X 24 rows = 4" X 4"

Finished size: 8" X 60"

Friendly Note: slip 1st st pwise and k last st on every row to make a smooth nice chain edge.

Beg: CO 38 sts. work on 2 x 2 ribbing about 5”

Body: dec 1 st while work on row 1.

R1, 3, 5: Sl 1pwise, k5, *p5, k5*. Rep * 2 more times, k1.

R2, 4, 6: Sl 1pwise, p5, *k5, p5*. Rep * 2 more times, k1.

R7, 9, 11: Sl 1pwise, p5, *k5, p5*. Rep * 2 more times, k1.

R8, 10, 12: Sl 1pwise, k5, *p5, k5*. Rep * 2 more times, k1.

Rep R1-12 totally 26 time. Then work on 2 x 2 ribbing about 5”. BO and weave ends.

Knitting terms:

BO	bind off
CO	cast on
k	Knit
p	purl
pwise	purl wise
rep	repeat
R	row
Sl	Slip
St(s)	Stitch(es)
2 x 2	K2, p2

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
