

Fringed Cowl

This sassy Fringed Cowl is a beginner project that will receive a lot of compliments!

This cowl is an easy project that looks great and adds a new fashion level to any outfit.

Yarn: 1 ball Yarn bee / Soft & Sleek DK (held 2 stands together); Cedar /#06
4oz / 114g (478yds / 437m);

1 ball Yarn Bee / Feeling Gradient / Bouquet the Day, (1 strand) 77%
Acrylic, 23% Polyamide 5.3oz/ 150g (590yds / 540m);

Finished weight: 3.5oz

Needle: 16" short tip short circular needle US 11 (8mm), US 10.5 (6.5mm), and US
10 (6mm)

Notions: Ring marker; crochet hook.

Gauge: 21 sts x 22 rows = 4" X 4" in largest needle / garter sts

Finished size: 11" (28cm) wide at bottom; 9" (23cm) wide at top; 12" (30cm) tall

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Fringe: Cut 16" long strands of yarn fold in half to make a the 8" long fringe with 3 strands each.

Friendly Note: May be made as long as you would like.

Beg: Hold 3 strands of yarn k as 1, CO 60 sts, K in the round in garter sts;

Garter sts = Rnd 1: k; Rnd 2: p

Start with needle size US 11 for 4", change to size US 10/5 for 5", change to size US 10 for 3". BO, weave all ends. Add fringes as sample photo shows.

Knitting Abbreviation:

Beg = begin

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit,

p = purl

Rnd = round

Sts = stitch(es)

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
