## Boreal Baby Booties



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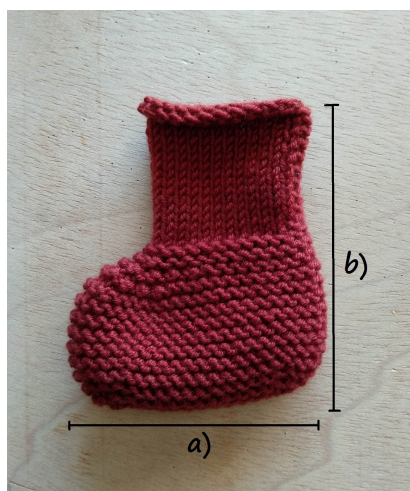
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**Expert Level:** Advanced Beginner

**Approx. Finished measurements:**

Size	Sole (a)	Height (b)
0-1m	±8cm / ±3"	±11cm / ±4,5"
1-3m	±9cm / ±3,5"	±12cm / ±4,75"
3-6m	±10cm / ±4"	±12cm / ±4,75"
6-9m	±11cm / ±4,5"	±13cm / ±5,25"
9-12m	±12cm / ±4,75"	±13cm / ±5,25"



**Tension:** - 24 stitches x 48 rows = 10cm / 4" in garter st with 3,5mm (US 4) needles.

### Materials:

- Yarn: approx. 1 ball / 40-65meters of yarn  
Katia 100% Merino 50g/102m or Merino 4 Us  
Rosários 4.

- 3,5mm (US 4) circular, straight or double pointed needles
- tapestry needle for finishing
- scissors

### Abbreviations:

approx. - approximately

beg - beginning

cm - centimeters

K - knit

K2tog - knit 2 stitches together

Kfb1 - knit in the front and back of stitch

P - purl

PM - place marker

RS - right side

SL1 - slip a stitch

SM - slip marker

st(s) - stitch(es)

WS - wrong side

YO - yarn over (makes a new stitch)

**Note:** All the sizes of this pattern were tested and I did my best to ensure that these instructions are accurate and complete. However I cannot be responsible for variations in individual work, typographical errors, or if the specified yarn weight recommended for this pattern has not been used. It is very important that you complete a tension square with the yarn and needles of your preference.

**SIZES:** 0-1 (1-3, 3-6, 6-9, 9-12) months

We start working the sole of the bootie.

☑ Cast on 31 (37, 41, 47, 53) sts.

☐ Row 1 (RS): Knit all sts.

☐ Row 2 (WS): Knit all sts.

☐ Row 3 (RS): K1, Kfb1, K11 (14, 16, 19, 22) sts, Kfb1, K1, K1, K1, Kfb1, K11 (14, 16, 19, 22) sts, Kfb1, K1.

You have 35 (41, 45, 51, 57) sts.

☐ Row 4 (WS): Knit all sts.

☐ Row 5 (RS): K2, Kfb1, K11 (14, 16, 19, 22) sts, Kfb1, K2, K1, K2, Kfb1, K11 (14, 16, 19, 22) sts, Kfb1, K2.

You have 39 (45, 49, 55, 61) sts.

☐ Row 6 (WS): Knit all sts.

☐ Row 7 (RS): K3, Kfb1, K11 (14, 16, 19, 22), Kfb1, K1, Kfb1, K3, Kfb1, K1, Kfb1, K11 (14, 16, 19, 22), Kfb1, K3.

You have 45 (51, 55, 61, 67) sts.



On the sizes **Newborn** (1-3, 3-6) months:

☐ Rows 8-20: Knit all rows, ending on a wrong side row.

On the sizes **6-9** (9-12) months:

☐ Rows 8-24: Knit all rows, ending on a wrong side row.



☐ Next Row (RS): Knit 14 (17, 19, 22, 25) sts, [SSK] x 4 times, K1, [K2tog] x 4 times, Knit 14 (17, 19, 22, 25) sts.

☐ Next Row (WS): Knit all sts.

You have 37 (43, 47, 53, 59) sts.

☐ Next Row (RS): Knit 10 (13, 15, 18, 21) sts, [SSK] x 4 times, K1, [K2tog] x 4 times, Knit 10 (13, 15, 18, 21) sts.

☐ Next Row (WS): Knit all sts.

You have 29 (35, 39, 45, 51) sts.



**ONLY FOR THE FOLLOWING SIZES:**

On the sizes **1-3** (3-6) months, make the two next extra decreasing rows:

☐ Next Row (RS): Knit 13 (13) sts, [SSK] x 2 (3) times, K1, [K2tog] x 2 (3) times, Knit 13 (13) sts.

☐ Next Row (WS): Knit all sts.

You have 31 (33) sts.

On the sizes **6-9** (9-12) months, make the four next extra decreasing rows:

☐ Next Row (RS): Knit 16 (15) sts, [SSK] x 3 (5) times, K1, [K2tog] x 3 (5) times, Knit 16 (15) sts.

☐ Next Row (WS): Knit all sts.

You have 39 (41) sts.

- **Next Row (RS):** Knit 15 (16)sts, [SSK] x 2 times, K1, [K2tog] x 2 times, Knit 15 (16)sts.
  - **Next Row (WS):** Knit all sts.
- You have 35 (37)sts.

**FOR ALL SIZES NOW:**

- **Next Row (RS):** Knit 12 (13, 14, 15, 16) sts, SSK, K1, K2tog, Knit 12 (13, 14, 15, 16) sts.
  - **Next Row (WS):** Knit all sts.
- You have 27 (29, 31, 33, 35)sts.

**ANKLE**

- **Next Row (RS):** Knit all sts.
  - **Next Row (WS):** K2, Purl until 2 sts remain, K2.
- Repeat these last two rows until you have a total of 18 (20, 20, 22, 22) rows (or the length you desire), ending on a wrong side row.



- **(RS):** Cast off all sts, leaving a long tail, in order you can use to sew the back and sole seams.
- I advise you to use an elastic bind off, like the Lace Bind Off (see how at the end of the pattern), but you can use the method you prefer.



- **Turn the bootie on the right side and sew the back and bottom seams.**
- I advise you to use an invisible vertical seam, like the mattress stitch seam on garter stitch, but you can use the method you prefer.

- **Weave in all the yarn ends.**
- **Repeat all the previous steps for the second bootie.**

**CONGRATULATIONS!!**

You have just knitted a cute pair of baby booties!

***\*\* Lace Bind Off - Elastic Cast Off \*\****

*(RS): knit 2 sts.*

*Insert your left hand needle into the front of those 2 knitted sts.*



*Wrap the yarn around the right hand needle and pull it through those 2 sts (it is almost like knitting the second part of a SSK (slip slip knit)). And you stay with 1 st on your right hand needle.*



*Now knit 1 st. You have again 2 sts on your right hand needle. And repeat the previous steps until the end of the row.*
