DETAILS

Method	Knitting
Skill Level	Intermediate
Needles	Straight Knitting Needles 4 mm / US 6
Notions	Stitch marker Tapestry needle Row counter Three small buttons
Yarn	Katia Merino DK, shade 004, Red 1 x 50g ball
Gauge	10x10 cms (4" x 4")= 22 sts x 30 rows 4mm needle, stocking st
Instructions	Written format.
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ABBREVIATIONS

k	knit
p	purl
yo	yarn over
sl1	slip one stitch
pssso	pass the slipped stitch over the stitch just knitted
cm	centimeters
in / "	inches
st(s)	stitches
meas	measures

PATTERN

Note: This headband is knitted flat. Buttons holes are created naturally in the pattern so you can stop knitting to your desired length if you need the length smaller or larger.

1. EDGING

Using 4mm (US 6) straight needles cast on
18 sts.
k 2 rows

2. PATTERNING

Row 1 (WS): k1, *p1, k1, p2, k1, rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1

Row 2 (RS): k1, *k1, p1, k1, yo, k1, p1, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2

Row 3: k1, *p1, k1, p3, k1, rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1

Row 4: k1, *k1, p1, sl1, k2, pss0, p1, rep from * to last 2sts, k2

Rep rows 1 - 4 until work meas approx 46 cms / 18" or your desired length.

3. CLOSING EDGE

k 2 rows.
Cast off.

4. TO MAKE UP:

Weave in loose ends and block to open up the lace work.

Sew three small buttons to one end of the headband, filling the eyelets at that end.

Use the eyelets on the opposite end to fasten the headband.
