

# SUMMER LIGHT COVERLET

Babies need a light coverlet even during the warmer summer months. This pretty lace coverlet is worked primarily in garter stitch with just a touch of eyelets for visual interest and to keep the knitter alert.

## Materials & Supplies

1 skein Plymouth Yarn Sockotta (45% Cotton, 40% Superwash Wool, 15% Nylon) 414yds/100gr color 14, or other fingering weight yarn  
US size 5 (3.75mm) needles *or size needed for gauge*  
12" ribbon

## Finished Measurements

Approx. 17" x 18" as knit. Block and stretch as desired.

## Gauge

5.5sts=1" over garter stitch eyelet pattern

## Notes

Keep an eye on your remaining yarn as you approach the upper border.

## Instructions

CO 91 sts. Knit 6 rows.

## Lace Pattern Stitch

**Row 1 (rs):** k3, \*k7, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo; repeat from \* to last 4 sts, k4

**Row 2 (ws):** knit

**Row 3:** k3, \*k8, yo, sl2, k1, p2sso, yo, k1; repeat from \* to last 4 sts, k4

**Rows 4 thru 8:** knit

**Row 9:** k3, \*k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k6; repeat from \* to last 4 sts, k4

**Row 10:** knit

**Row 11:** k3, \*k2, yo, sl2, k1, p2sso, yo, k7; repeat from \* to last 4 sts, k4

**Rows 12 thru 16:** knit

Repeat the 16 rows of the Lace Pattern Stitch until piece measures approx. 16 ½" ending after working a Row 4 or 12.

## Upper Border

Knit 6 rows. BO *very loosely*. Weave in ends. Block, gently stretching coverlet to show lace patterning. Securely tie a pretty bow to upper left corner through a couple of the eyelets.



## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>BO</b>	bind off
<b>CO</b>	cast on
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 together
<b>p2sso</b>	pass 2 slipped sts over k st
<b>rs</b>	right side
<b>sl2</b>	slip 2sts together knitwise
<b>ssk</b>	slip, slip, k2tog thru back loop
<b>st</b>	stitch
<b>ws</b>	wrong side
<b>yo</b>	yarn over
