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Safety guidelines

The items in these patterns are not suitable for babies and very young children.

Knitting yarns

Small oddments of Double knitting in various colours, as stated in the instructions

Abbreviations

P - Purl. P1 - Purl one. Pwise - Purl Wise.

K - Knit, Kl - Knit one, Kwise - Knit Wise

Sts - stitches.

K2 tog - Knit 2 Together. P2 tog - Purl 2 Together.

Inc 1 - Increase 1 stitch. Y.Fwd - Yarn forward around needle.

St-st - Stocking Stitch. G-st - Garter stitch,

B+T tightly - Break off yarn leaving a long end and thread it through stitches left on knitting needle, pull together tightly then fasten off.

Additional instructions - for some of the detailing you will need to be able to make a chain stitch.





Knitted in DK Wool

For This Project - You need.

Knitting yarns.

Fawn for Chico Red for his coat

Additional materials.

Toy eyes Embroidery thread in Black Toy Stuffing – Small bag.

Tools.

No.10 needles. UK sized Wool needle. UK sized Sewing needle. Scissors.

Front legs, neck and head. (One piece)

Cast on 4 Sts on No.10 needles in Beige. KW Incl into every st P 1 row KW Incl into every st p 1 row St st 2 rows. (Kl, K2tog) to last 2 sts, K2tog St st 13 rows.

Put this aside on a needle and make a second leg in the exact same way. Once you have both legs done, put on one needle.

Put both sets of stitches on one needle with right side facing, then knit across both legs to join.

St st 10 rows.

Next row -***P2tog, P to last 2 sts, P2tog.

Kl row**.

Repeat from *** to ** until 14 Sts remain.

Do not K the last row

Increase for the head as follows.

Kl, (Inc 1, Kl), Kl P 1 row. (20 Sts) (Kl, Incl) to end

St st 11 rows.

Next row - (K3, K2tog) to end.

Next row - (P2, P2tog) to end.

Next row - (K1, K2tog) to end.

P2 tog to end. B+T tightly.



To make up

Sew from top of the head, down to where the neck is and stuff. Draw a little wool through the increase for head row and pull tight for neck (using an in and out stitch around the neck and pulling a little tighter to draw in). Sew down body and stuff as you go to the point where legs begin. Sew legs from joint between legs down each and stuff leaving bases of the feet open. There will be a flat line down back of head this is normal Leave this piece aside for now.

Back legs and rump.

Leg (Make 2)

Cast on 4 Sts on No.10 needles in Beige. KW Incl into every st P 1 row KW Incl into every st St st 3 rows. (K1, K2tog) to end St st 13 rows.

Once second piece is knitted put both sets of stitches on one needle (20 sts) right side facing and K across both legs

Next row - St st 10 rows

Next row - (P3, P2tog) to end

Next row - (K1, K2tog) to end

Next row - (P2tog) to end, P1

B+t tightly

To make up

Draw thread tightly and sew down to where legs meet, stuff well. Join legs and sew down each one, stuffing and leaving bases open.



Middle section of body

Cast on 15 Sts on No.10 needles in Fawn St st until work measures 7.5 cm. Approx 32 rows. Cast off.

To make up

Sew cast off edge to cast on edge, making a tube shape. Stuff lightly to hold shape and sew back legs to one open end and front legs to other - making sure the seams are facing into the tube on both pieces, and the stomach seam faces down. Add more stuffing before closing completely, to stiffen. This is quite tricky to sew together and you may find using safety pins to hold in place while sewing helpful.

Ears (make 2)

Cast on 10 Sts
P 1 row
KW Inc 1 in every st.
P 1 row
Next row - K4, K2tog, to last K2.
P 1 row
Next row - K3, K2tog, to last 2
P 1 row
Next row - K2, K2tog to last 2
P 1 row
Next row - (P1, P2tog to last 2
P 1 row
Next row - (K2 tog) to end.
P 1 row
K2tog, twice
B+T tightly.



To make up

Fold in half and flatten to make a triangle shape. Sew up seam, move seam to center back, gather base in the center to pinch ear before sewing to dogs head at each side. Position is optional. Sew in place.

Muzzle

Cast on 15 Sts on No.12 needles in White.

K 1 row.

P2tog, P to last 2 sts, P2 tog.

K 1 row.

Repeat these last 2 rows until 9 Sts remain, ending on K row.

P2tog to end, P1

B+T tightly.


Draw tightly to close the end, sew up side seam. Stuff lightly and sew onto front of Unicorns face. Leave enough space on the upper part of face for eyes and fringe.

Tail

Cast on 6sts Stst 20 rows K2tog to end B+T

Sew seams up without stuffing the tail, gather base to close and sew to

dogs rump.



Coat

In red Cast on 20 stst K 2 rows K2, P to last 2 sts, K2 K 1 row Repeat last 2 rows, 7 more times K2, P4, cast off 8 sts, P4, K2 Work on first 6 sts K4, K2 tog P2tog, P1, K2 K 1 row P2, K2 Repeat last 2 rows, 5 more times Cast off Rejoin to last 6 sts K2tog, K4 K2, P1, P2tog K1 row K2, P2 Repeat last 2 rows, 5 more times Cast off



Belly strap

Cast on 10sts in red Stst 2 rows Cast off

The coat lays on dogs back with the two front straps pulled around and overlapping at the front. Stitch or add a closure if you want it to be removable.

The belly strap is sewn at each center side as pictured. Make one side with a button or closure if you want it to come off. Mine is sewn in place
