

Needles

• A pair of 2mm knitting needles (You can use straight or circular needles)

Materials

- Toy filling (less than 50g)
- 5 Holders
- Sewing needle
- Scissors
- Sewing pins
- White felt for the shark's eyes

Notes

- Size: The finished toy is 15cm tall
- Work flat: All pieces are knitted flat
- Casting on: I prefer to use the long tail cast on for all pieces.
- Sewing seams: Use Mattress Stitch and Whip stitch to sew the seams.



Less than 50g in each colour:

• Susan's Family Alpaca



Black 30



Blue 27



White 01



Yellow 16



Gray 12

Please note:

 If you use the same yarn I did – Susan Alpaca – you will need to double the yarn and use 2mm knitting needles.

Alternatively, you can choose other yarn weights that do not require doubling, as long as the needle size is suitable.

Abbreviations

K Knit

P Purl

Kfb *Increase:* Knit front and back

Increase: With your right needle, come from behind and scoop up the right loop of the 'V' stitch just below the stitch on your left needle. Lift this loop onto your left needle, then knit it.

two rows below the one on your right needle. With your left needle, come from behind to scoop up the left loop of this stitch. This loop on the left needle becomes the new stitch. Insert the tip of your right needle through the back loop and knit it.

K2tog *Decrease:* Knit two stitches together

P2tog *Decrease:* Purl two stitches together

K3tog *Decrease:* Knit three stitches together

St(s) Stitch(es)

St st Stockinette Stitch: Knit all stitches on right side rows, purl all stitches on wrong side rows.

(...sts) The number in round brackets at the end of the instruction indicates the total number of stitches after completing the row.

Knitting Pattern

The penguin

Leave a long tail for sewing, then cast on 8 stitches using the black yarn.

Row 1: K1, KFB x6, K1 (14 sts)

Row 2: P

Row 3: K1, (K2, KLL) x6, K1 (20 sts)

Row 4: P

Row 5: K1, (K3, KLL) x6, K1 (26 sts)

Row 6: P

Row 7: K1, (K4, KLL) x6, K1 (32 sts)

Row 8: P

Row 9: K1, (K5, KLL) x6, K1 (38 sts)

Row 10: P

Row 11: K1, (K6, KLL) x6, K1 (44 sts)

Row 12: P

Row 13: K1, (K7, KLL) x6, K1 (50 sts)

Row 14: P

Row 15: K10, KLL, K30, KLL, K10 (52 sts)

Row 16 – Row 18: St st ("K" all stitches on right side rows,

and "P" all stitches on wrong side rows)

In this section, you will be working with color changes (Intarsia knitting), so it's helpful to divide the yarn into small balls before starting.

This will make it easier to switch colors as you knit.
