Knitting pattern by **Cheryx**



The 36th dream

Needles

- A pair of 2mm knitting needles
(You can use straight or circular needles)

Materials

- Toy filling (less than 100g)
- Sewing needle
- Scissors
- Sewing pins
- 3 small buttons, 1 cm each (*I used orange, green, and beige buttons*).
- 2 Markers
- 3 Holders
- A pair of tweezers makes it easy to add stuffing to small knitted pieces.

Notes

- **Size:** The finished toy is 23 cm tall
- **Work flat:** All pieces are knitted flat
- **Casting on:** I prefer to use the long tail cast on for all pieces.
- **Sewing seams:** Use Mattress Stitch and Whip Stitch to sew the seams.

Yarns

Less than 50g in each colour:

- Susan's Family Alpaca


 Orange 42

- Susan Shetland

 Green 23

 Light Brown 35

 White 01

 Dark Brown 38

 Yellow 06

 Black 42

Yellow and black yarns are used only for the little bee. You can use the same yarn I used or any yarn you have, but ensure it matches the weight so the pieces are the correct size.

Please note:

If you use the same yarn I did – Susan Alpaca – you will need to double the yarn and use 2mm knitting needles.

Alternatively, you can choose other yarn weights that do not require doubling, as long as the needle size is suitable.

Abbreviations

K	Knit	C4F	Slip 2 stitches onto a cable needle and hold in front, knit the next 2 stitches from the left needle, then knit the 2 stitches from the cable needle.
P	Purl	C4B	Slip 2 stitches onto a cable needle and hold in back, knit the next 2 stitches from the left needle, then knit the 2 stitches from the cable needle.
Kfb	<i>Increase:</i> Knit front and back	K2tog	<i>Decrease:</i> Knit two stitches together
KRL	<i>Increase:</i> With your right needle, come from behind and scoop up the right loop of the "V" stitch just below the one on your left needle. Lift this loop up into your left needle. Knit the loop.	K3tog	<i>Decrease:</i> Knit 3 stitches together
KLL	<i>Increase:</i> After working a knit stitch, identify the stitch 2 rows below the one on your right needle. With your left needle, come from behind to scoop up the left loop of this stitch. Insert the right needle tip through the back loop and knit.	P2tog	<i>Decrease:</i> Purl two stitches together
C2F	Slip 1 stitch onto a cable needle and hold in front, knit the next stitch from the left needle, then knit the stitch from the cable needle.	St(s)	Stitch(es)
C2B	Slip 1 stitch onto a cable needle and hold in back, knit the next stitch from the left needle, then knit the stitch from the cable needle.	St st	<i>Stockinette Stitch:</i> Knit all stitches on right side rows, purl all stitches on wrong side rows.
		(...sts)	The number in round brackets at the end of the instruction indicates the number of stitches after working the row.

Knitting Pattern

Start knitting from the pumpkin stem down:

Cast on 8 stitches with green yarn (Leave a long tail for sewing).

Row 1: K1, (K2, KFB) x2, K1	(10 sts)
Row 2: K1, P1 , K2, P2 , K2, P1 , K1	(10 sts)
Row 3: P1 , K1, P2 , K2, P2 , K1, P1	(10 sts)
Row 4 – Row 15: Repeat Row 2 - Row 3 six times.	
Row 16: K1, P1 , K2, P2 , K2, P1 , K1	(10 sts)
Row 17: P1 , KRL, K1, P2 , K1, KRL, K1, P2 , KRL, K1, P1	(13 sts)
Row 18: K1, P2 , K2, P3 , K2, P2 , K1	(13 sts)
Row 19: P1 , K2, P2 , K3, P2 , K2, K1	(13 sts)

Let's start knitting!
