

Needles

• Two pairs of 2mm knitting needles (You can use straight or circular needles)

Materials **

- Toy filling (less than 50g)
- 5 Holders
- 2 markers
- Small multicolored beads, 3 mm in size
- Sewing needle
- Scissors
- Sewing pins

Notes

- Size: The finished toy is 22cm tall
- Work flat: All pieces are knitted flat
- Casting on: I prefer to use the long tail cast on for all pieces.
- Sewing seams: Use Mattress Stitch and Whip stitch to sew the seams.



Less than 100g in each colour:

• Susan's Family Alpaca





• Susan's Family Shetland





• The black yarn is only used to embroider the snowman's two arms, and it requires very little yarn, so you can use any black yarn you have as long as the yarn size is suitable.



Please note:

If you use the same yarn I did – Susan Alpaca and Shetland, you will need to double the yarn and use 2mm knitting needles.

Alternatively, you can choose other yarn weights that do not require doubling, as long as the needle size is suitable.





abbreviations

K Knit

P Purl

Kfb *Increase:* Knit front and back

KLL Increase: After working a knit stitch, identify the stitch 2 rows below the one on your right needle. With your left needle, come from behind to scoop up the left loop of this stitch. This loop on the left needle is the new stitch. Insert the right needle tip through the back loop and knit.

CDD Decrease: Slip 2 stitches together as if to knit a k2tog, knit 1 stitch, then pass the slipped stitches over.

K2toq *Decrease:* Knit two stitches together

P2tog *Decrease:* Purl two stitches together

K3tog *Decrease:* Knit three stitches together

P3toq *Decrease:* Purl three stitches together

St(s) Stitch(es)

St st Stockinette Stitch: Knit all stitches on right side rows, purl all stitches on wrong side rows.

(...sts) The number in round brackets at the end of the instruction indicates the total number of stitches after completing the row.



Knitting Pattern

Snowman

Using white yarn, cast on 8 sts (leave a long tail for sewing).

Row 1: K1, KFB x6, K1 (14 sts)

Row 2: P

Row 3: K1, (K2, KLL) x6, K1 (20 sts)

Row 4: P

Row 5: K1, (K3, KLL) x6, K1 (26 sts)

Row 6: P

Row 7: K1, (K4, KLL) x6, K1 (32 sts)

Row 8: P

Row 9: K1, (K5, KLL) x6, K1 (38 sts)

Row 10: P

Row 11: K1, (K6, KLL) x6, K1 (44 sts)

Row 12: P

Row 13: K1, (K7, KLL) x6, K1 (50 sts)

Row 14 – Row 38: St st ("K" all stitches on right side rows, and "P" all stitches on wrong side rows)

Row 39: K1, (K4, K2tog) x8, K1 (42 sts)

Row 40: P

Row 41: K1, (K3, K2tog) x8, K1 (34 sts)

Row 42: P1, (P2tog, P2) x8, P1 (26 sts)

Put markers at the start and at the end of the row just worked.

Row 43: K (26 sts)

Row 44: P

Row 45: K1, (K4, KLL) x6, K1 (32 sts)

Row 46: P

Row 47: K1, (K5, KLL) x6, K1 (38 sts)

Row 48: P

Row 49: K1, (K6, KLL) x6, K1 (44 sts)
